-

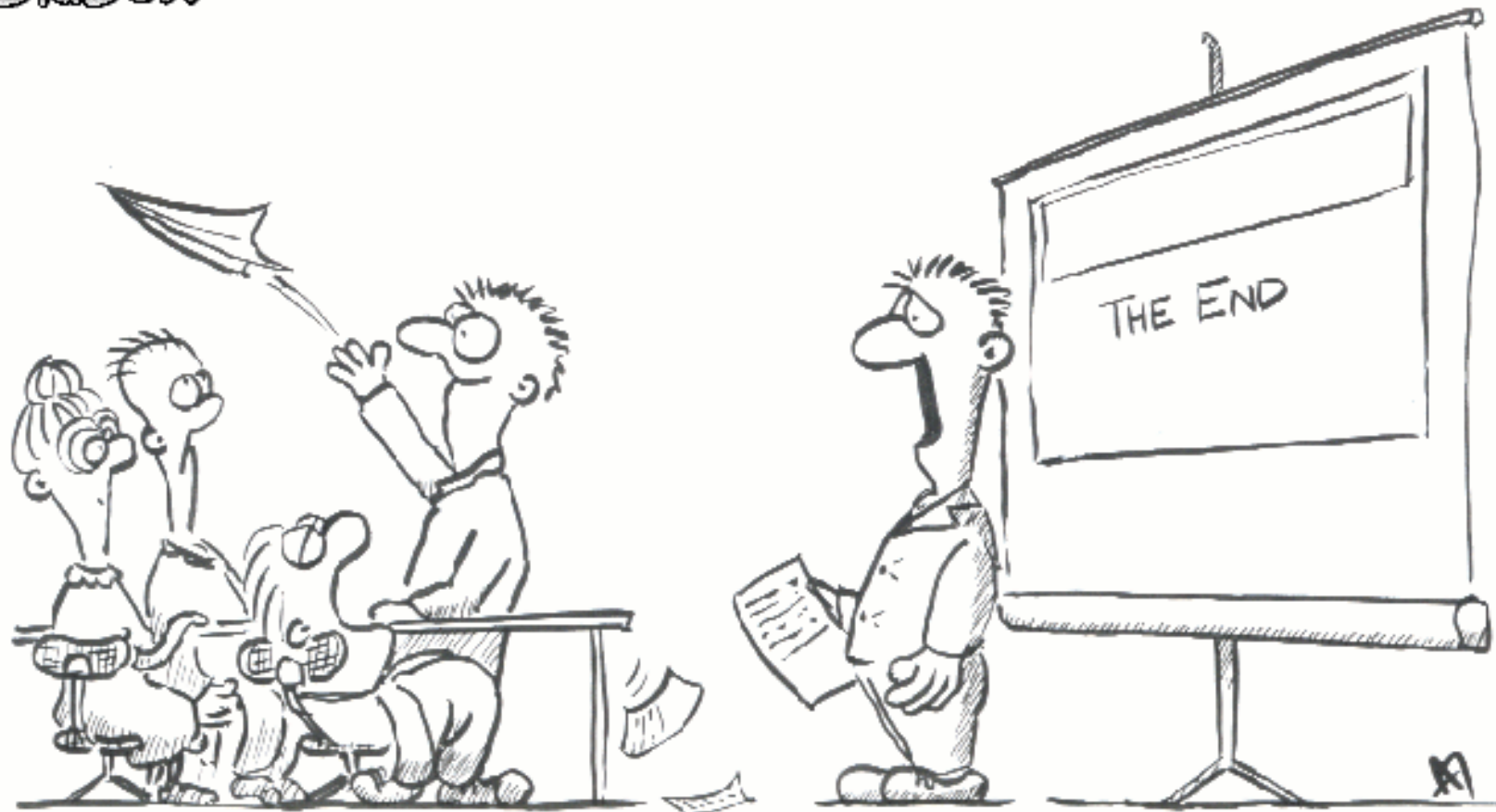
How to present well?
